1. Welcome/Announcement

All the members of the Student Council congratulated to each other for New Year and Christmas.

2. Approval of Minutes of 24 December, 2003

4. New Logo

There were already some versions available for Student Council new Logo, which were presented during the Student Council meeting. The prototypes were very beautiful and interesting. As some examples were not fully ready, it was decided to keep working on it and

choose one of the presented versions later. Student Council members expressed their opinions about the presented logos, which would be taken into consideration while working over them.

5. Life-Long E-mail

Sergey Arakelyan reported that he had already had a meeting with Ruzan Balayan as a member of Alumni Association board and found out that only at the end of January 2004 there will be elections of new board and after elections SC can meet and discuss the issue related to Life-Long E-mail. Also it was repeated that the new E-mail service should be provided from April 1. AUA Student Council is concerned about deadlines and will actively cooperate with Alumni association in order to begin the implementation of this project.

6. Restart English Club Activities

Sergey Arakelyan noted that Armen Abrahamyan did a very good job in operating the Movie Club. He was very careful in choosing tapes for Movie Club, which always were interesting to watch. Louise Manukian stressed that a special range of laws and by-laws should be defined for English Club. The regulations should be worked out, where the activities of the English Club and responsibilities of the English Club members would be clearly stated.
