1. Welcome/Announcement

2. Approval of Minutes of 30 January, 2004

The minutes of January 30, 2004 were approved as written.

3. Agenda Review

4. Printing Information

Sergey Arakelyan and Luise Manukyan clarified the issue of printing in the computer laboratory. In past students were given their printing limits for every quarter corresponding to the number of

courses they were taken (50 pages for every course), now the students are given their limit of printing all together for two years (for 2nd year students one year up to graduation) and students are free to consume it whenever it is appropriate for them. Whether students will need to print during vocations or during the classes it will not require any additional payment if it is within their given limits. However, students have the responsibility to be reasonable in their printings not to consume their limited number of pages. The cost of every printed page exceeding the stated limits will be charged from students for 40 drams. Also, it was requested to make available the printing usage of each student every 15 days on the board of the computer laboratory in order students know how many pages they have already consumed.

5. Valentine's Day

Student Council members decided to prepare beautiful posters for Valentine's Day, as well as to congratulate all AUA students' Valentine's Day. Narine Hayrapetyan took responsibility to prepare and send a greeting letter with a greeting card to the AUA students. Also it was decided to prepare AUA Student Council suggestion box as Valentine's Box. The received letters would be delivered people whom the letters are addressed.

6. Web-Page

Student Council members were discussing the Student Council web page, specifically its logo, pictures, construction and design. Tigran Mathevosyan took responsibility to update the web-page design.

7. By-Laws

Luise Manukyan introduced in short the By-Laws for AUA English Club activities.
